**Syllabus for
Mid Term (2017-18)
Class VII**

English :

Separate question paper and answer sheet format replaces the combined booklet format form :

Maximum marks – 80

Duration of Assessment – 3 hrs.

The assessment will be divided into four sections.

Section A	-	Reading	-	20 marks
Section B	-	Writing	-	20 marks
Section C	-	Grammar	-	20 marks
Section D	-	Literature	-	20 marks

Section A – Reading (20 marks)

Two unseen reading passages. The passages will be extracts from factual / descriptive / literary / discursive passages. Questions will test inference, evaluation and vocabulary. The total length of the 2 (two) passages will be between 650 and 800 words, 10 marks each.

Section B – Writing (20 marks)

This section assesses the student on the ability to use appropriate vocabulary and grammar, expand an idea and deal with compositions based on virtual stimulus.

This section shall include :

Three tasks as indicated below

1. Paragraph writing
2. Informal letter writing
3. Article Writing

Section C – Grammar (25 marks)

Following Grammar concepts will be judged :

1. Verbs
2. Tenses
3. Adjectives
4. Pronouns
5. Synonym, Antonym
6. Nouns
7. Sentences

Section D – Literature (25 marks)

Two extracts from prose and poetry followed by 4 - 5 questions to test local and global comprehension of the set text.

One question testing comprehension, local or global of a poem or play from the reader. (word limit – 100 words)

Two or three questions based on one of the texts from the prescribed reader to test local or global comprehension of the set text. An extract may or may not be used.

Word limit – one or two lines if an extract is given 25-30 words if not.

One extended question based on prose texts from reader to test global comprehension and extrapolation beyond the set text. Word limit 150 words.

It may be a Diary Entry or a Character Sketch.

Questions will test comprehension skills of the students. Chapters included:

1. The Camel's Complaint
2. Daffodils
3. Tippitty
4. Windmill in Trouble
5. Eagle

Note : All the exercises discussed, explained and done at the end of the chapters in Literary Reader and Work Book shall be included. The chapters must be read thoroughly and the glossary will also be included.

Mathematics :

Academic achievement (in the subject) of the learner will be evaluated on the basis of Understanding the mathematical skills, Application of acquired knowledge and Calculation skills and Geometrical skills

The question paper will be of 80 marks and will be divided into 4 sections.

section A will contain 4 questions of 1 mark each.

Section B will contain 5 questions of 2 marks each.

Section C will contain 10 questions of 3 marks each.

Section D will contain 9 questions of 4 marks each.
