Today, they stand proudly enriched and more knowledgeable than ever.



Inter House Robo-Tricks - A Robotics Spectacle

Robo-Tricks, a Robotics Competition, made its debut at Rajmata School on **14th October 2023.** This event brought together the brightest young minds from Classes VI-A and VII-A to showcase their talent and innovation in the field of Robotics. The competition was meticulously designed to encourage creativity, teamwork, and problem-solving. Twenty students, selected through rigorous criteria, were divided into four teams, each representing one of the school's houses. The competition featured a unique draw of lots, where each house was assigned the task of creating a different type of Rover. The teams had approximately 2 hours to assemble their Rovers and develop the Code.

The competition was judged based on the following criteria: 1. Code Cleanliness, 2. Circuit Accuracy, 3. Presentation & 4. Bot Performance.

The competition was fortunate to have a distinguished panel of Judge: Mr. Jasvinder, Dean IT at RKK, whose unwavering support and guidance were instrumental in making this competition possible. Mr. Jitendra, A respected techie in the school, brought a wealth of experience and expertise to the judging panel.

Competition Highlights - Each team built Rovers falling under the categories of obstacle-avoiding Bots and Push Bots with variations in sensor usage, particularly focusing on Infra-Red and Ultrasonic Sensors. After the projects were ready, each team was required to present their Bots to the judges explaining both the hardware and logic implementation and were required to show the working of their Bot. Judges cross-questioned each team, providing valuable feedback and guidance for improvement and future research. An arena was created by the IT team to test the functionality of the Rovers, offering a real-world testing scenario.

Awards and Recognition: At the conclusion of the competition, the winning team was awarded prizes. Certificates of participation were given to the Runner-Up team
