



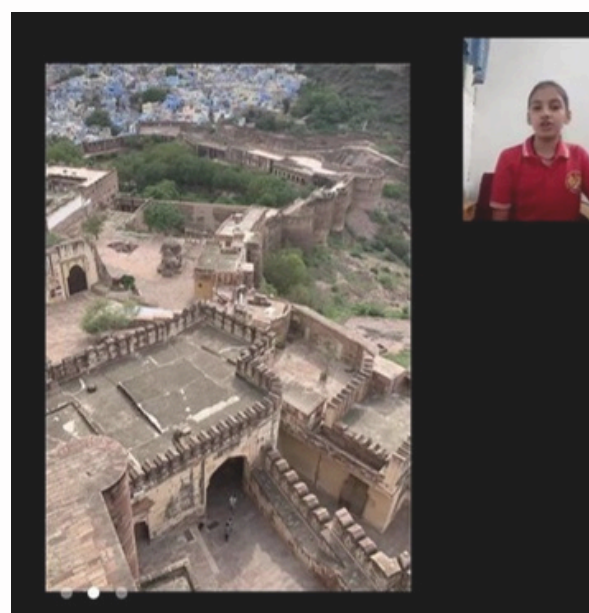

It was a great intercultural and a learning experience for the students. Through this journey, the students gained a lot of confidence and presentation skills.

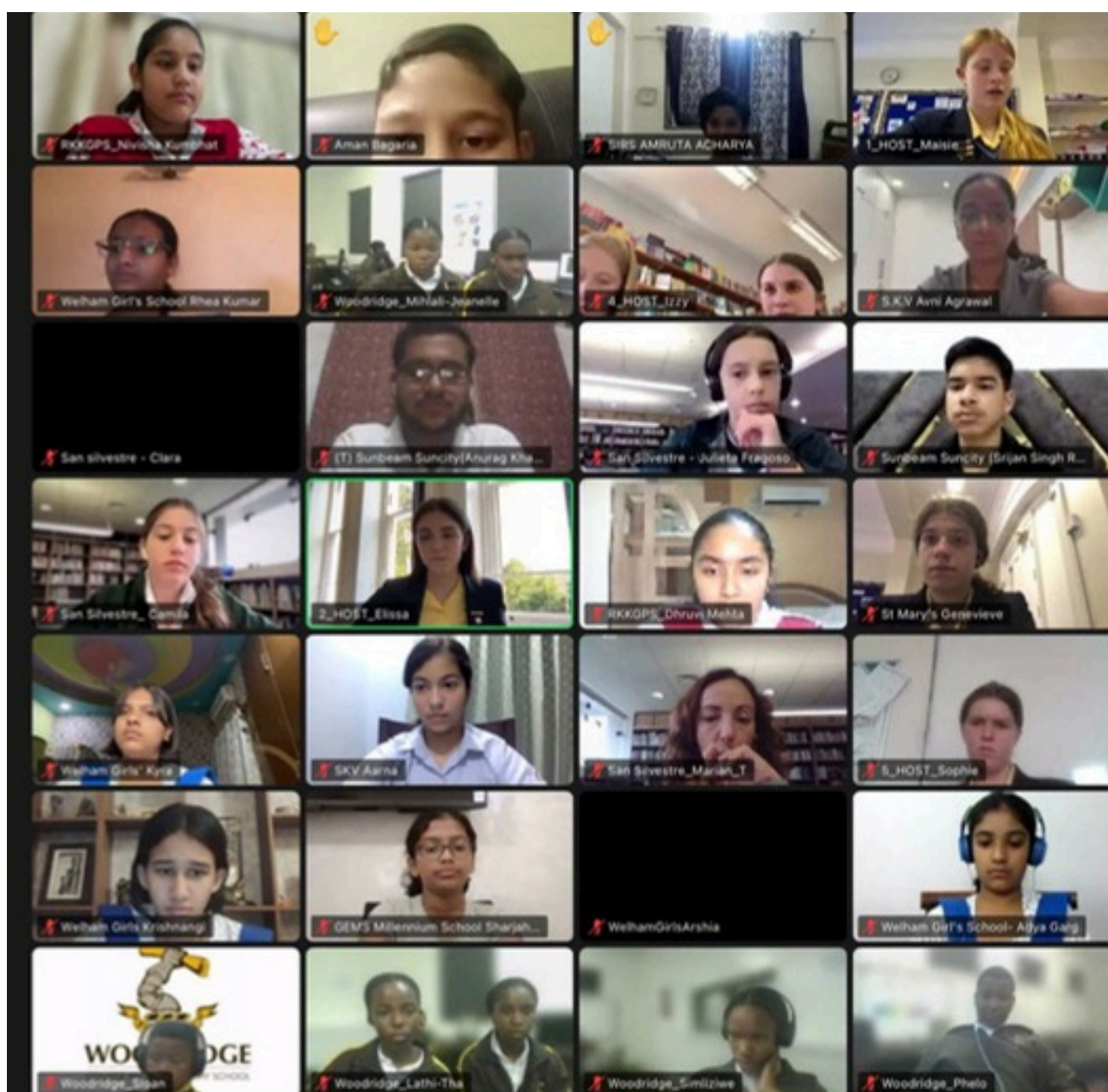

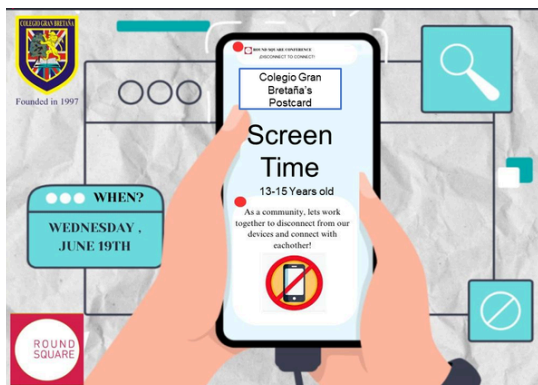


## Private Realschule Gut Warnberg, Germany (RS Zoom Postcard)

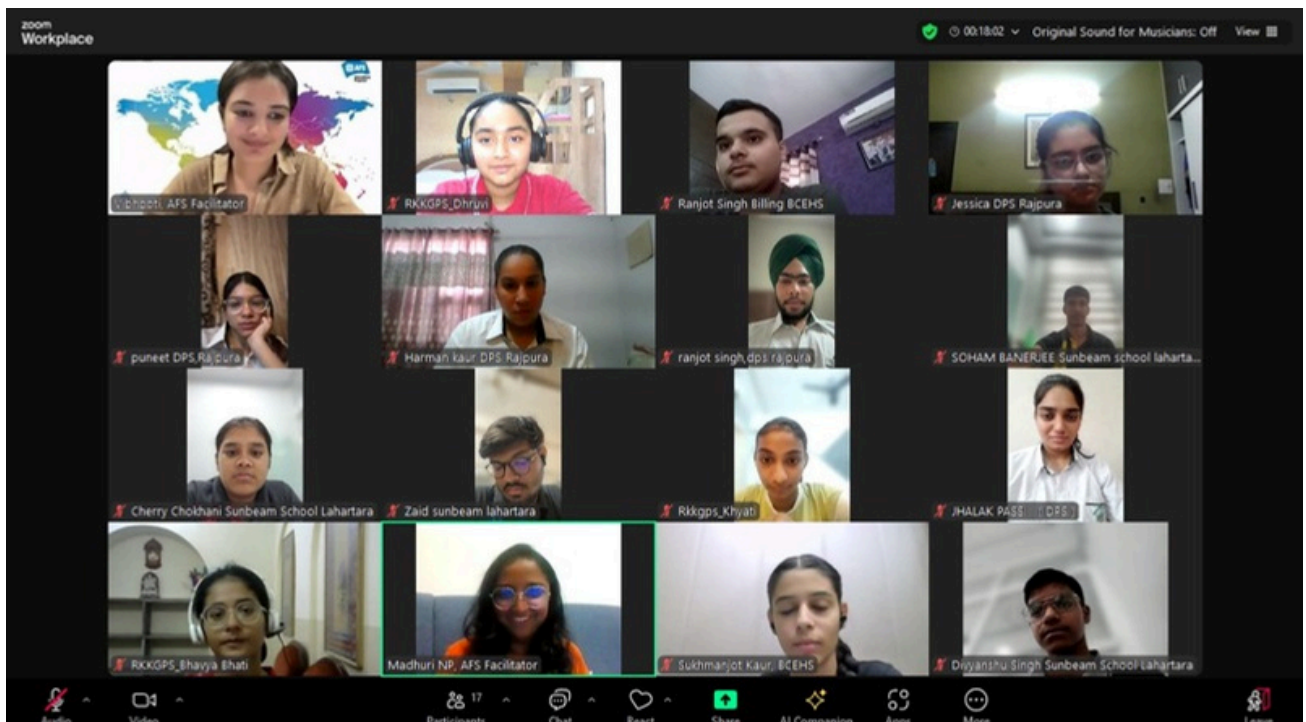
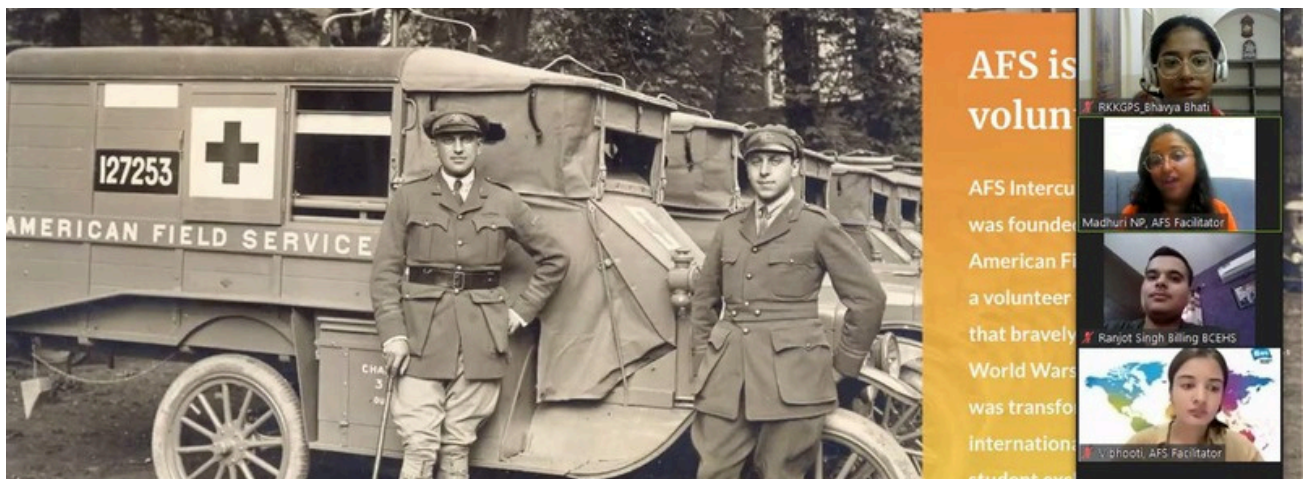




## ICL Training Workshop for Students

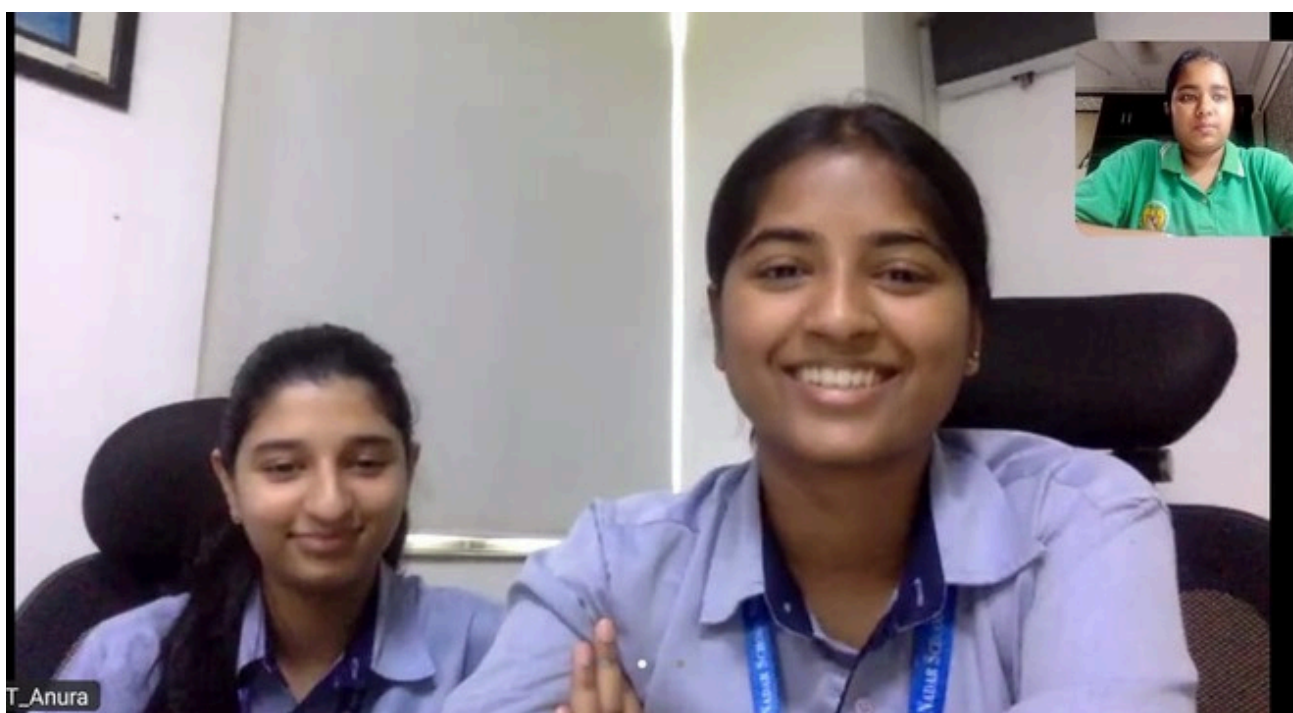
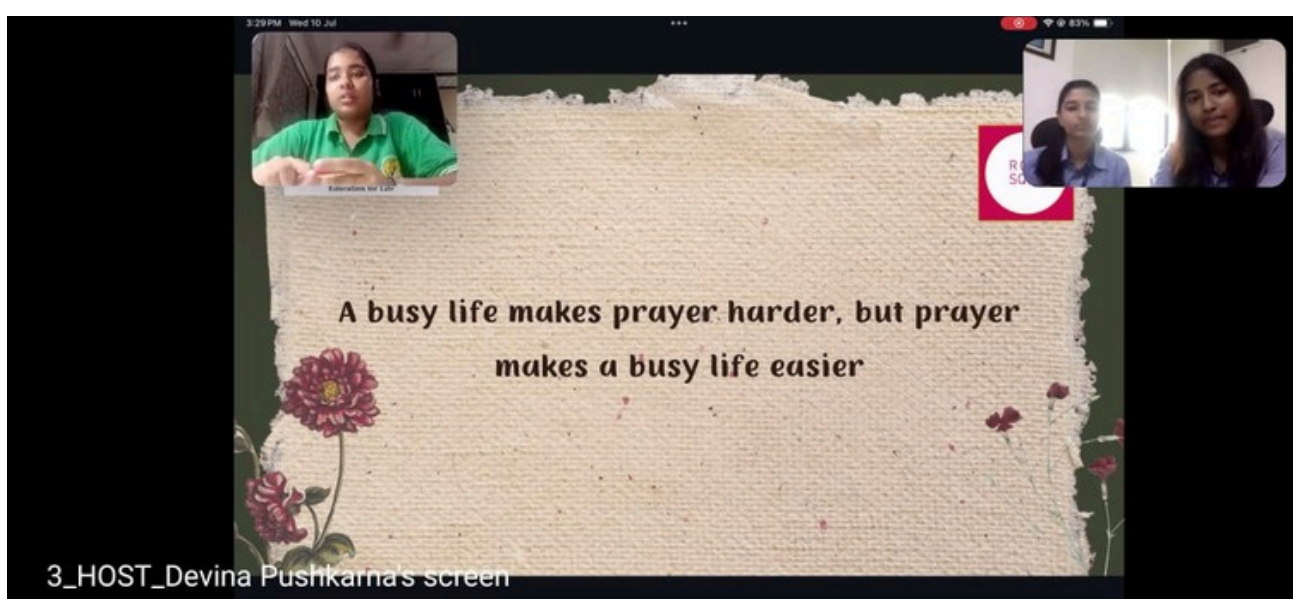

(On the Occasion of RKK's 32nd Birthday)

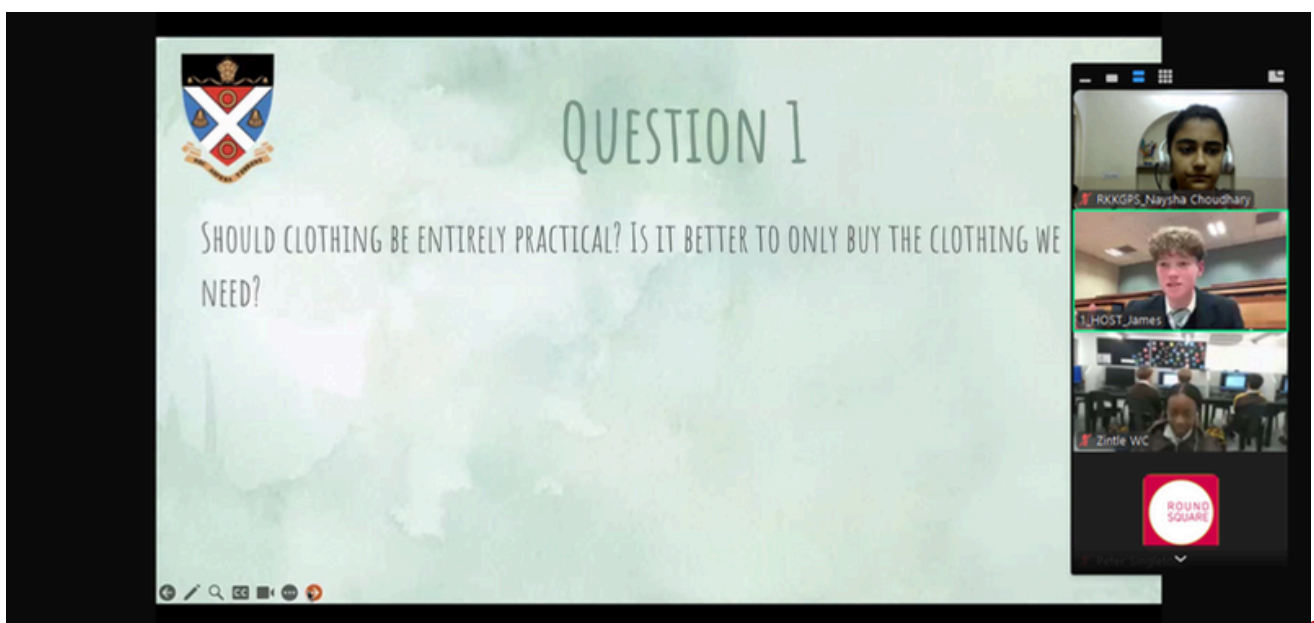
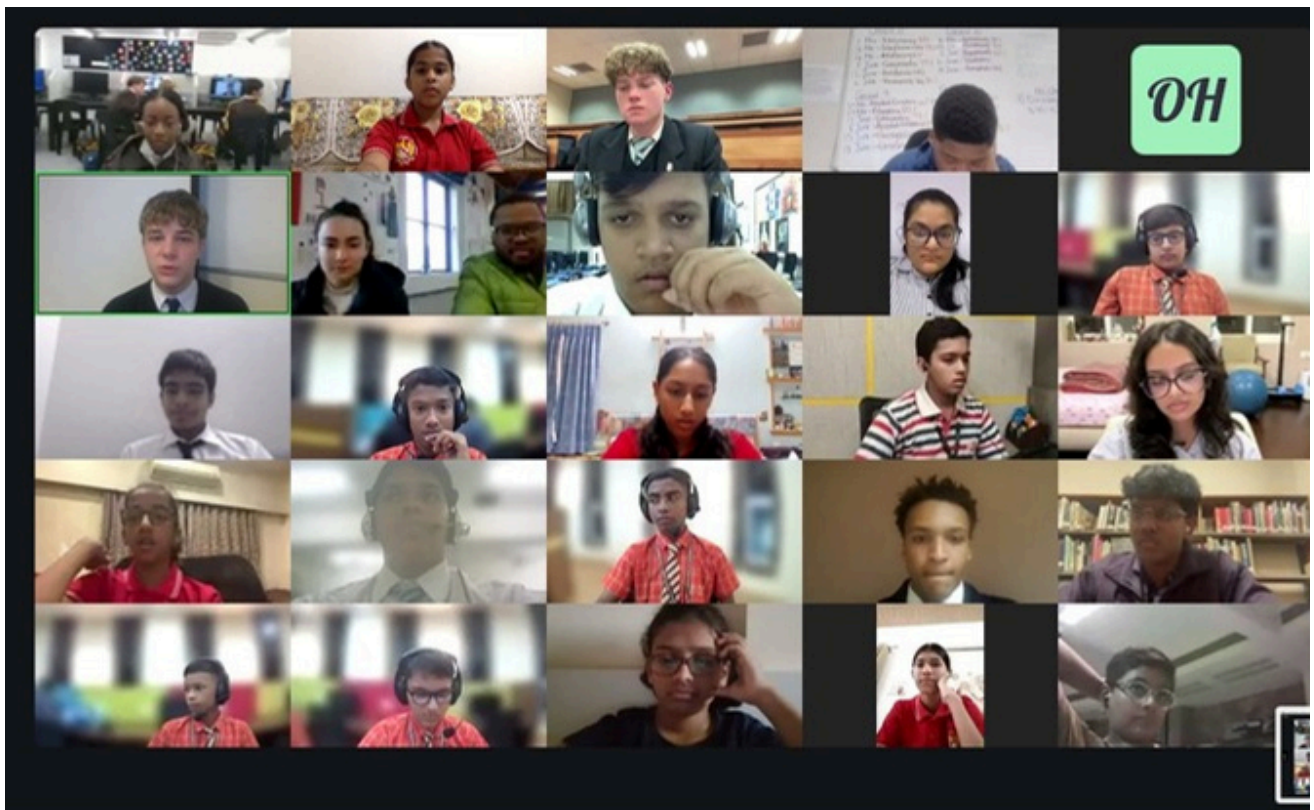

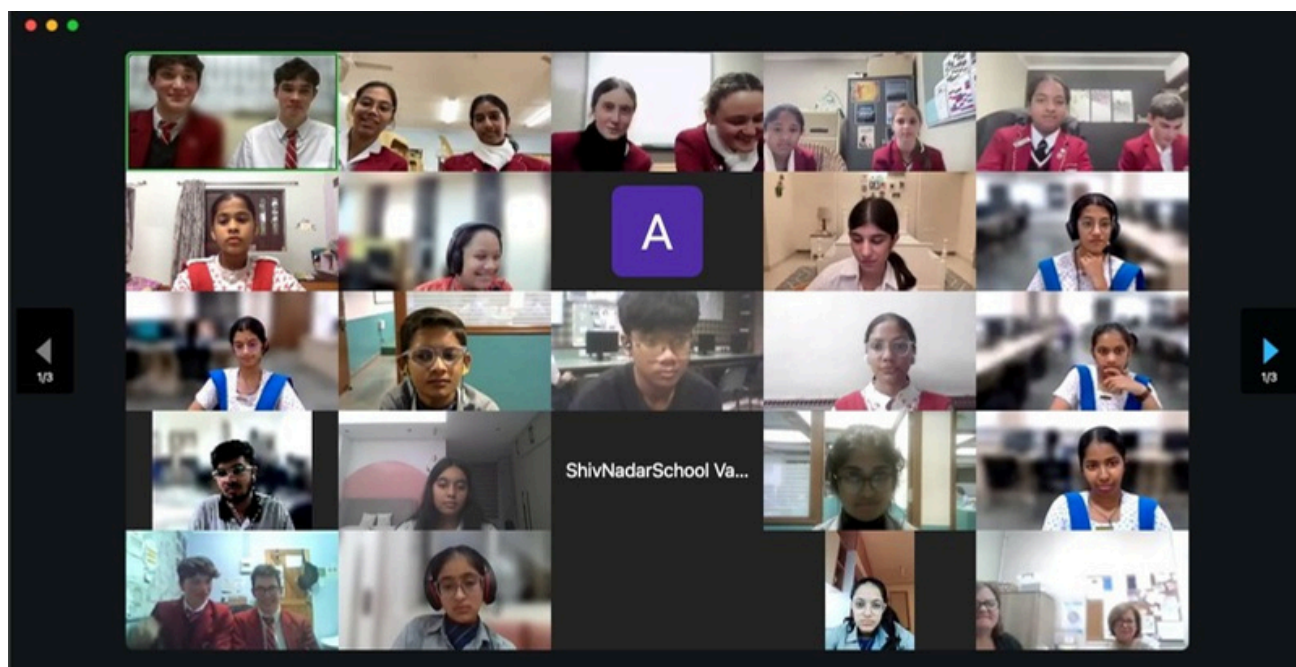


## Thomas More College, South Africa (RS Zoom Postcard)

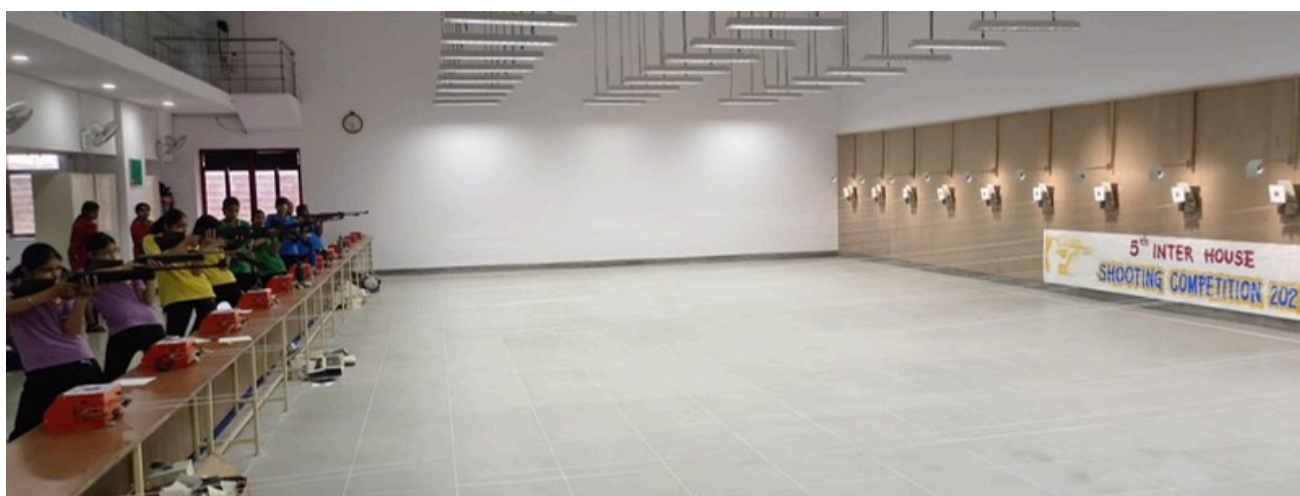

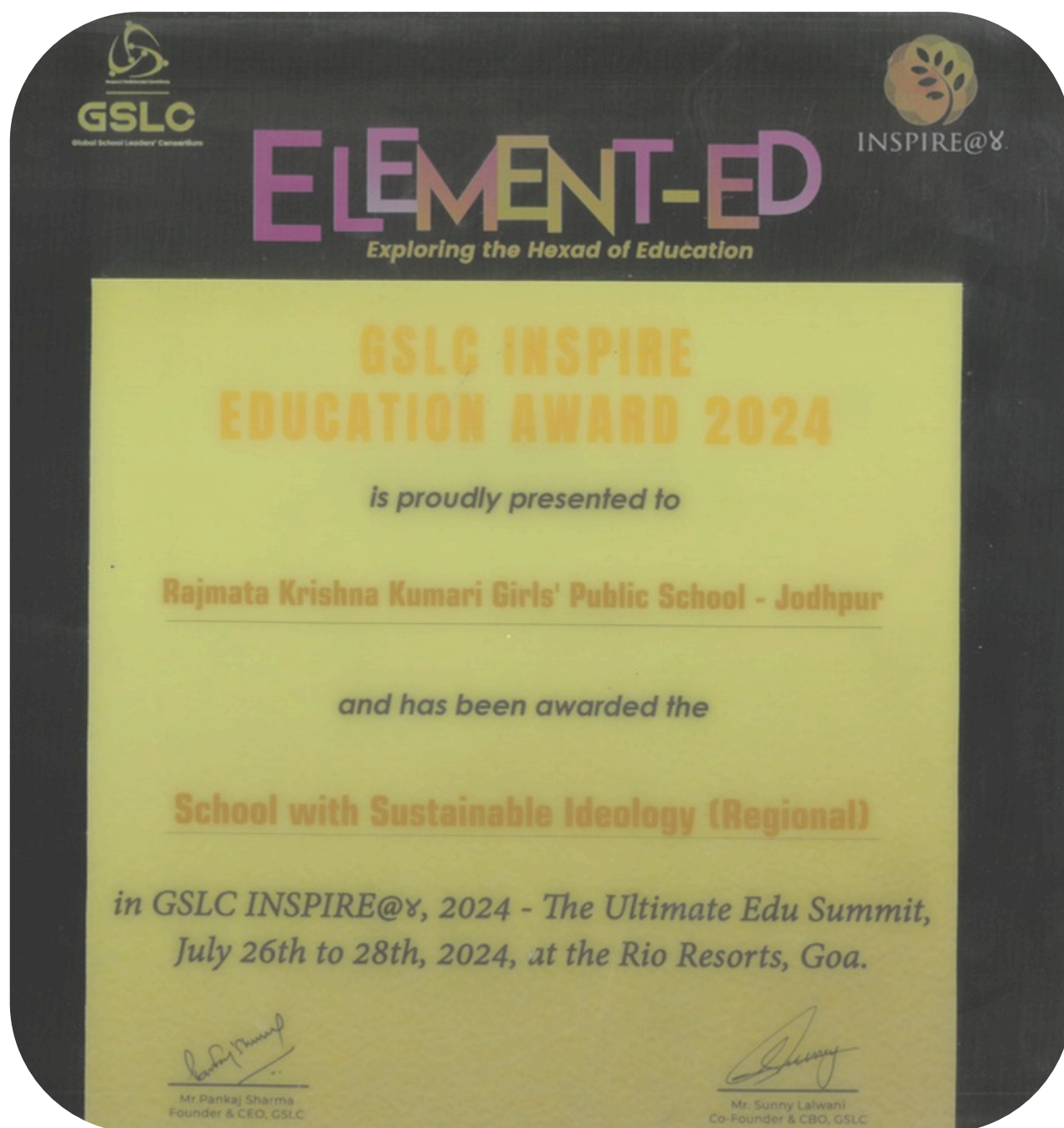
